A RESOLUTION TO: Restrict the Change of Roads To Toll Roads

WHEREAS: the Citizens of Texas have been taxed to create a fund to build and maintain transportation rights-of-way; and,

WHEREAS: a state Department of Transportation has been designated to oversee the construction, design and maintain these rights-of-way for quality and safety; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the 11th Texas Silver-Haired Legislature encourage and strongly recommend that the 80th Texas Legislature pass legislation to prohibit the use change of any street, road, or highway constructed with tax dollars from being out-sourced, sold, leased, or conveyed to any Group, Company, Corporation, Board, Authority, Organization, or Individual for the purpose of charging the citizens of the state of Texas a fee for use.
